 - Auxiliary aids and services: Note-takers; telephone handset amplifiers; written copies of oral announcements; assistive listening devices; assistive listening systems; telephones compatible with hearing aids; telecommunications devices for deaf persons (TDDs); or other effective methods that help make aurally delivered materials available to individuals who are deaf or hard of hearing.
- Provides free language services to people whose primary language is not English, such as:**
 - Qualified interpreters either on staff, by telephone, or by video chat.
 - Information written in select languages
